APA Style for Government, NGO and Treaty Documents

Government Documents:

General Format:

Government Organization. (year). *Title of the Document*. Publisher info or Retrieved from...

Example:

Government of Canada. (2016). *Part 1: Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. Constitution Act, 1982*. Retrieved from <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/const/page-15.html>

NGO Documents:

General Format (Directly from the APA Style Blog):

1. Name of the agreement
2. Article Number
3. Paragraph Number

Example: Article from the United Nations
U.N. Charter art. 5, para. 13

Treaties:

- 1. Bilateral Treaties (a treaty between 2 parties):** Title of Agreement, Party A-Party B, date. Retrieved from...

Example:

Agreement of Agriculture Between Canada and the Swiss Confederation, Canada-Switzerland, July 1, 2009. Retrieved from <http://www.treaty-accord.gc.ca/text-texte.aspx?id=105107>

- 1. Multilateral Treaties (a treaty between 3 or more parties):** Title of Agreement, Party A-Party B-Party C, date. Retrieved from...

Example:

Amendment to the Convention on Future Multilateral Cooperation in the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries, Canada-Cuba-Denmark-European Union-Iceland-Norway-Russian Federation, September 28, 2007. Retrieved from <http://www.treaty-accord.gc.ca/details.aspx?id=105136>
