

Graduation Requirements for Honours Sociology

Checklist for Students

The Honours BA Sociology program consists of 20.0 credits, not more than 6.0 of which may be at the 100 level.

A minimum of 10.0 and a maximum of 14 credits in Sociology must be completed including: SY101, SY102 (or SY103 and EN190 effective Fall 2017), SY203* (or SY207 and SY208 effective Fall 2016), SY210, SY280, SY281, SY382; SY389.

1.5 additional SY credits at the 300 level, and 1.5 SY credits at the 400 level.

The following checklist is based on the minimum required 10.0 credits in Sociology. Do not take more than 14.0 Sociology credits.

¹SY102, SY103 and EN190 do not need to be taken in first year in order to major in Sociology, and are not a prerequisites for second year courses. If you switch to Honours Sociology after first year, you can take SY103 and EN190 in your second year. (SY102 is no longer offered effective Fall 2017)

Reminder:

- **DO NOT TAKE MORE THAN 6.0 credits at the 100 level**
- To progress in honours Sociology you need a GPA (average) of 5 (C) or more in your Sociology courses and a GPA of 5 (C) or more overall (all courses combined).
- To graduate with honours, you need a GPA of 7 (B-) or more in Sociology and 5 (C) or more overall. Check with the other honours program for their requirements

To graduate with honours, you require 20.0 credits in total.

It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that all academic program and course requirements have been met. Please refer to the regulations in the Laurier Calendar.
